

# Talent Quest- Intercollegiate Competition

## Guidelines for various competitions

### Solo Song

1. Only a maximum of two participants are allowed from one college.
2. Karaoke or any other musical instruments are not allowed.
3. Time limit given for performance is max 3 min.
4. Judges decision will be final.

### Variety Program

1. Maximum number of participants is 10.
2. The time allotted per team is 10 minutes and one team only permitted per college.
3. In the 10 minutes allotted the teams can perform songs, dance, skits, mimes etc but an underlying theme should be maintained throughout.
4. Decency should be maintained through out the performance.
5. All presentations must be within the delineated area of the stage, including entry & exit points.
6. The stage should not remain empty for more than 1 minute in between the allocated time.
7. Karaoke and instruments if required have to be arranged by the participants.
8. The committee is not responsible for the failure of any recorded CD.
9. Participants should bring their own CD. The CD should only contain the song to be used for the performance. Kindly bring a backup CD. Music system will be provided.
10. All clothes and accessories are to be arranged by the participating team. The organizing committee will be responsible only for the infrastructure facilities.
11. Language of the play can be English/ Hindi.
12. No explicit sexual references, gestures, or swearing will be allowed.
13. Acts shall not include representation of any nationality or race in ridicule.
14. Usage of the following are prohibited
  - a. Fire crackers or loud explosions.
  - b. Throwing or handing candy, gum, souvenir, or other items at or to the crowd.
  - c. Use of any live animal or fowl, domestic or wild.

### Quiz Competition

1. A team shall consist of three persons
2. The decision of the quiz-master will be final and will not be subjected to any change.
3. The participants shall not be allowed to use mobile or other electronic instruments.
4. The questions shall be in the form of multiple choice, True / False statement, Specific-answer question etc.
5. Audience shall not give any hints or clues to the competitors.
6. Replacement of any participant of a team is not allowed after registration
7. Teams selected for the final rounds will be allowed to give themselves an appropriate name related to the competition by which they may want to be known

### **Quiz Elimination Round – (In case more than 6 teams register) on .....**

- Each team would be given a set of question paper containing 25 multiple choice objective type questions
- Time limit - 10 minutes
- Only 6 Teams would be selected for STAGE ROUNDS
- In case of tie between 2 or more teams, further 5 questions would be asked for final selection
- The selected teams shall have to appear for the final round

### Poster Presentation

1. The poster presentation has to be done on any one of the below mentioned topic:
  - a. Emerging microbial diseases
  - b. Laboratory safety
  - c. Quality control in clinical laboratories
2. The participant must mention the topic on which the poster is presented, below which they should mention their names and the name of their institution.
3. Number of participants is restricted to 2 per poster.
4. Participant should choose a speaker who will explain the topic presented.
5. Winner will be chosen based on the presentation of the poster as well as the explanation given by the speaker.
6. The poster should be 80cm X 60 cm in dimension. Font size for the heading should be 28, the abstract font size should be in 16. Maximum number of words in the abstract is limited to 300.
7. Participants must send in their abstracts by January 27<sup>th</sup>, 2012 to the Talent Quest coordinator.
